 Bob-white quail and/or chukars and/or pheasants released in all stakes except Open Puppy. A blank cartridge will not be fired in the Open Puppy stake. Horseback handling is permitted in all stakes. This trial will be recognized by the American Field. It may also be recognized by AFTCA, but be aware that you will need to pay an individual membership to AFTCA to have any win recognized.

All blank guns must have a solid barrel or be plugged
