All stakes open to all AKC registered pointing breeds. Bitches in season may compete in the Amateur Gun Dog only. AKC approved tracking collars may be used in all stakes per AKC regulations. This event is also recognized by the American Field Dog Stud book, but dogs must be registered with AKC in order to participate.

Total entries for other stakes limited to the number that can be run during daylight hours (approx. 65 dogs). Entries will close when this limit is reached if this occurs prior to the specified closing time. Entries accompanying the last entry may be accepted. No more than 50% of the entries in any one stake may be handled by the same handler.

Bob-white quail and/or chukars and/or pheasants released in all stakes except Open Puppy. A blank cartridge will not be fired in the Open Puppy stake. Horseback handling is permitted in all stakes. This trial will be recognized by the AFTCA and American Field

All blank guns must have a solid barrel or be plugged

Driving Directions

Grounds: 40°38'59.77"N, 103°28'54.60"W

From Brush, CO: Take State Hwy 71 north to State Highway 14. Go east (right) on SH 14 to County Road 11. Go north (left) on CR11 about 2 miles to County Road 30.7. Go east (right) on CR 30.7 about ¼-mile until it turns north (left) and becomes County Road 11.2. Continue on CR 11.2 another ¼-mile, the grounds will be on your left.
