COURSES AND BIRDS

Amateur Puppy and Open Puppy are single course without bird field, no birds released. Amateur Derby, Open Derby, Amateur Gun Dog, Amateur Limited Gun Dog (RET) & Open Gun Dog (RET) are single course without bird field. Amateur Limited Gun Dog (RET) and Open Gun Dog (RET) is a Call Back to Retrieve. Bring your BLAZE ORANGE.

Bobwhite quail, and/or chukars, and/or pheasants released in all stakes except Amateur Puppy and Open Puppy. A blank cartridge will not be fired in the puppy stake. Horseback handling will NOT be permitted in all stakes. This is an all walking Field Trial. Shotguns with blank shells will not be permitted.

Attention all Field Trial Participants, please remember we are guests of the Ohr Ranch. This is private grounds and must be kept clean. Smoking: Is allowed inside vehicles and campers only.

Light breakfast, lunch and dinner will be offered on Saturday by the GSPCC for a small fee, Light breakfast and lunch only on Sunday.

Training: There will be no training on the grounds 2 days prior to the trial no training is allowed on trial days. Once birds are released they become the property of the state. No recall devices are allowed.
