ENTRY LIMITS: All stakes will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run during daylight hours and will close when limits have been reached. No more than 50% of the entries in any stake may be handled by the same handler.

This trial will be run under the flexible format, and the club reserves the right to rearrange the running order, add or rearrange judges should conditions warrant.

COURSES AND BIRDS: AWP will be a single course without bird field, no birds released. No firing of blank cartridges in puppy stakes. AWP will be a 15-minute stake and AWD will be 20-minute stake. AWGD will be single course without bird field. AWGD is a non-retrieving stake.

Bobwhite quail, and/or chukars, and/or pheasants released. Shotguns with blank shells will not be permitted.

CAMPING

NO PARKING or STAKING OUT OF DOGS IN FRONT OF HOUSE. Ohr Farms will be charging \$10 per night per rig for overnight camping beginning Thursday, April 16, 2026. There are no hookups available. Please pay at the event with a check payable to GSPCC.

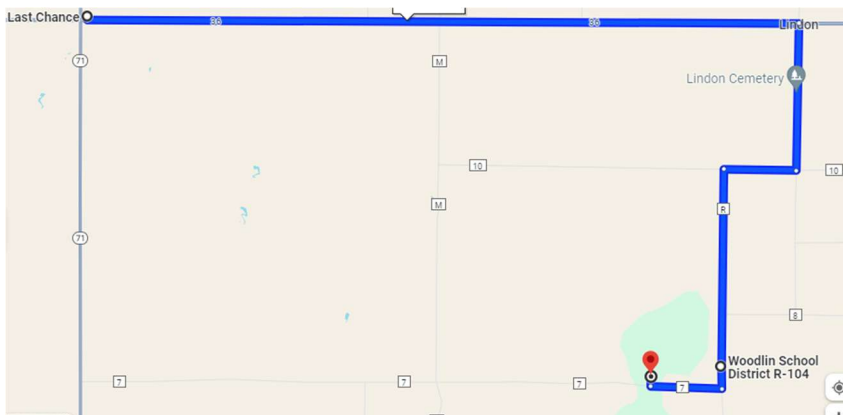

Please clean up after and fill in any holes created by your dogs and horses. Make every effort to preserve the natural environment, including vegetation, soil, water, and wildlife. Limited water will be available for horses. Please bring water for you and your dogs. Smoking is allowed ONLY in vehicles and campers. Once birds are released, they become property of the state. No recall devices are permitted. Rules apply during the trial and any period before or after the trial while a participant and/or guest occupy the grounds.

Waiver of Liability: An entry in this field trial constitutes a waiver of liability to the German Shorthaired Club of Colorado, its officers, members of/or owners of Ohr Farms for any accidents, damages, or injury in reference to the attendance at this field trial in conjunction with the dogs, horses, vehicles, trailers and any other personal equipment. **All participants, staff and guests will be asked to sign a waiver of liability for Ohr Farms prior to the start of the events.**

Go left (South) on Road R for 1 mile. Go right (West) on Road 7 for 1 mile. Go right (North) on Road Q for ½ mile. Road Q is the entrance to the trial area (Ohr Farms).
