**Driving Directions**

From Brush, CO: Take State Hwy 71 north to State Highway 14. Go east (right) on SH 14 to County Road 11. Go north (left) on CR11 about 2 miles to County Road 30.7 (aka CR 30.5). Go east (right) on CR 30.7 (aka CR 30.5) about ¼-mile until it turns north (left) and becomes County Road 11.2. Continue on CR 11.2 a few hundred yards, the grounds will be on your left. (Lat 40°38'59.40"N, Long 103°29'5.16"W)

**Trial Grounds will be at the south end of the property  
aka: the tubes**
