All tests open to all AKC Pointing Breeds that are at least 6 months of age and registered with, or granted an ILP by the AKC. Bitches in season are only allowed to run in the last stake of the day on each course. Please contact us for more information.

"Makes check payable to "RMVC". Payment must accompany entry. No dogs will be drawn or braced without prior payment. NO EXCEPTIONS."

Once an entrant is drawn and braced, it may run as entered, move up to the next test level, or scratch without refund. Refunds will be granted only for injured or sick dogs (may require vet certification); or as deemed an emergency by the event committee. Entrants who complete a title during #2015661111 may request advancement to the next level for event #2015661112 to the event secretary within 30 minutes of the test start.

COURSES AND BIRDS

Senior and Master Hunt Tests will run 30 minutes. Junior Hunt Test will run 15 minutes. Tests will run on a single course with bird field. **PHEASANT** will be released in all stakes. This is a unique opportunity to expose your dog to premium game birds.

Judges and officials only are allowed to use horses. Shotguns with blank shells will not be permitted. Only starter pistols with blank cartridges may be fired by handlers. Participants must wear blaze orange on the senior and master courses. Galleries are permitted only at the discretion of the hunt test committee and judges when safety permits, are under the control of the marshal, and not permitted in any bird field.

PRIZES

Standard AKC Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

HUNT TEST GROUNDS AND FACILITIES

The Rocky Mountain Vizsla Club will be hosting the event on the location identified above. Land east of County RD 157 is the property of Strasburg Game Birds. The RMVC has no control over the private use of that land.

All participants are required to complete a Release of Liability and Waiver to Strasburg Game Birds upon entrance to the grounds. The release form will be available at the grounds.

The Rocky Mountain Vizsla Club, any of its members, or the owners of Strasburg Game Birds will not be held liable for any damage or injury to participants, their horses, dogs, vehicles, trailers, and any other personal equipment.

Dogs are not permitted to be off leash except during the running of their brace. Participant vehicles are permitted only in the designated parking areas.

Please be sure to fill any holes left and leave no trash behind. We are guests at Strasburg Game Birds; please preserve our area for future use. Thank you!

Aurora CO is the closest city with hotels.

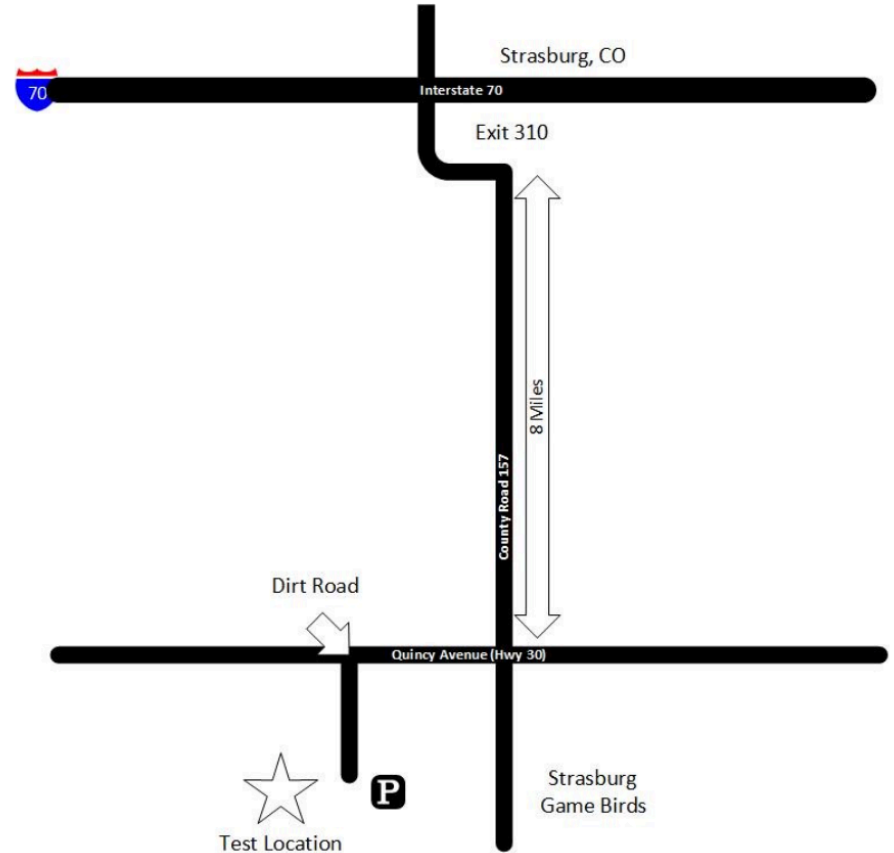
Hotels are also near the Denver International Airport.

5220 S County Rd 157, Strasburg, CO 80136
Take I-70 to Exit 310. Turn south and take an immediate left along the I-70 Frontage Road, which becomes CR 157. Proceed south approximately 8 miles to Quincy Ave. (HWY 30), turn right on Quincy Ave. Turn left to get to the hunt test grounds.
Watch for the Rocky Mountain Vizsla Club signs and orange streamers.
