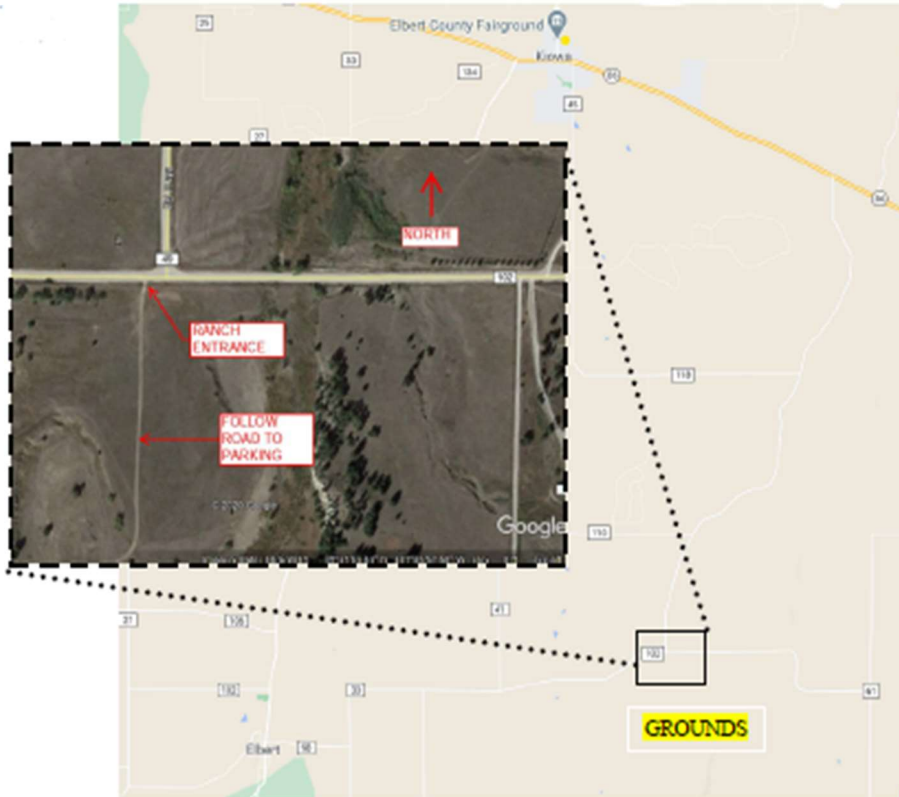

From Kiowa, CO: Take State Hwy 86 east to Maul Road (4 miles). Go south on Maul Road 6.5 miles until it dead ends at County Road 102.

From Elbert, CO: Go east on CR 98 (1 mile), go north on CR 33/CR 102 (5 miles) to Maul Road. The grounds will be through the gate on the south side of the intersection of Maul Road & CR 102. Smoking is allowed ONLY in vehicles.
