Total entries limited to the number that can be run during daylight hours (approx. 65 dogs). Entries will close when this limit is reached if this occurs prior to the specified closing time. Entries accompanying the last entry may be accepted. No more than 50% of the entries in any one stake may be handled by the same handler.

This trial is being run under the flexible format option and the club reserves the right to rearrange the running order of the stakes and add/rearrange judges if conditions warrant.

 Horseback handling is permitted in all stakes. This trial will be recognized by the AFTCA and American Field

All blank guns must have a solid barrel or be plugged

Entries

Handlers

Any age up to 18 years old, no experience required!

Dogs

Handlers may choose to run their own dog, a family member's dog, a friend's dog, or experienced dogs will be available for juniors to run at the trial. All breeds (and crossbreeds), ages, sexes, and religions of dogs will be allowed to enter. The stake will be judged on the handler's ability & enthusiasm (so the dog's caliber/training/experience is not a factor).

Running

Horseback handling permitted, but not required. Accommodations will be made for young/inexperienced riders. Firing of blank guns & nerf guns is permitted but not required (blank guns allowed according to the age of the dog). The stake will be 20 minutes long.

Parents

Parents will not be allowed to assist juniors (oodles of experienced assistance will be on hand to help the handlers).

Judges

Judges will be announced during the drawing.

Prizes
