Courses and Birds

There are two courses: Courses A and B may run concurrently.

-Open Puppy and Open Derby are non-retrieving stakes. Birds will be blanked on course.

-Open Limited Gun Dog, Open Gun Dog, Open All-Age, and Amateur Gun Dog are retrieving stakes. Birds will be blanked on course, with a Call Back for the retrieve.

-Chukar, quail, or pigeons planted in all stakes except Puppy.

*Note – shot gun blanks are not permitted.

NOTE TO TRIAL PARTICIPANTS AND VISITORS

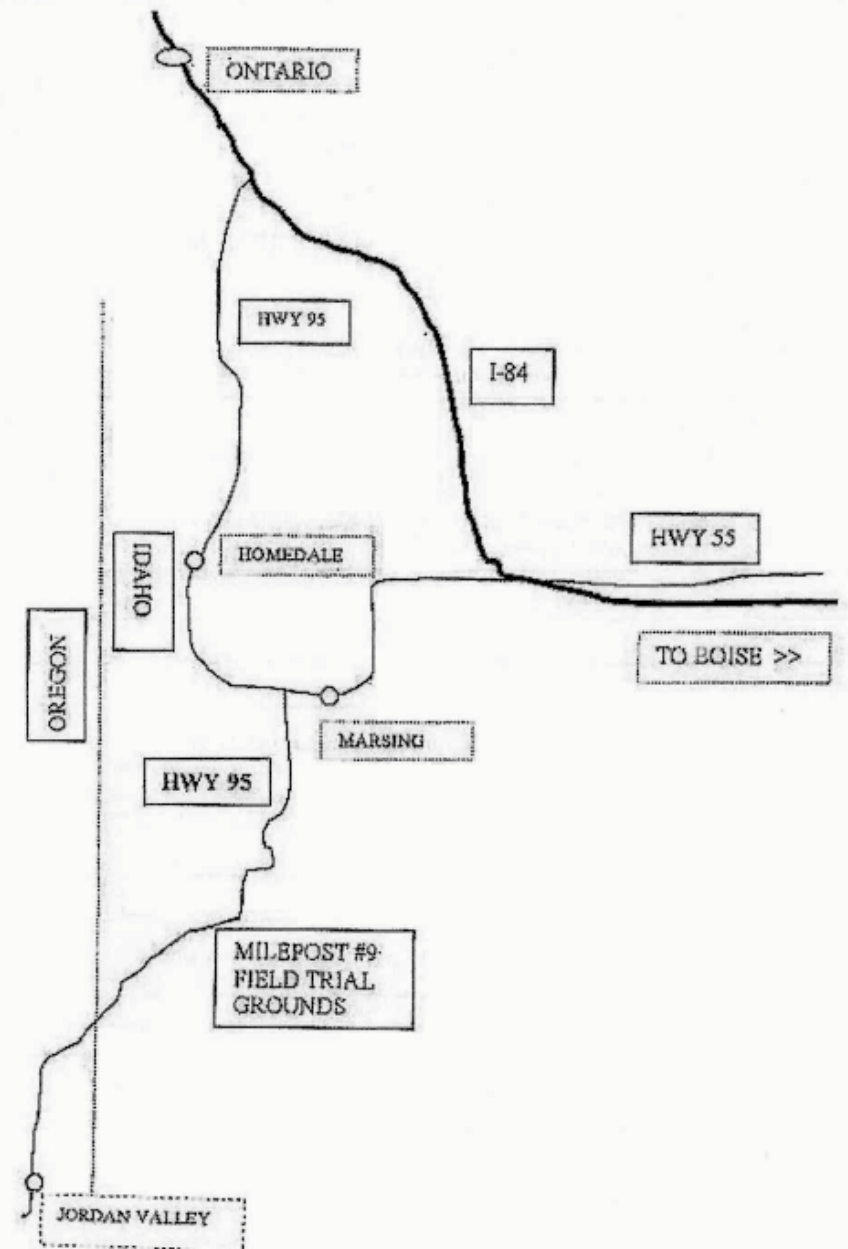
The GSPCI is using BLM grounds for this trial. Certified Hay or pellets are required for horses. Water will be provided for the animals. Please keep the grounds clean. Dry camping is available at Mile Post #9 trial grounds. Please pick up after your animals and leave the site in good shape. All participants, guests, and entries are accepted on the condition that the GSPCI, Inc. and the landowner are released from liability for loss, damage or injury sustained by people, dogs, or horses in connection with the trial.

TRAVEL ADVISORY: Because of extensive roadwork on Hwy. 55, in Nampa, we advise an alternate route, from Interstate 84, to Milepost #9, on Hwy. 95 south. Take exit 27 (Wilder/Homedale), from I-84 and take Hwy.19 west, to Hwy.95, then south to the trial grounds. Motel accommodations are available at Best Western Caldwell Inn and Suites (exit 29, at I-84), phone 208-454-7225.

FOOD: A social hour will be held after Friday's event. Breakfast and Lunch will be available for the judges and participants on Sat. and Sun. The Club will host a tailgate BBQ on Saturday evening, at the trial grounds. GSPCI members are invited to bring side dishes/desserts to share! Time: 5:00 pm

MAP/DIRECTIONS:

Milepost #9 is located on Hwy 95, approx. 15 miles south of Marsing (Hwy 55) and Homedale (Hwy 95). Field trial grounds are located 1 mile east of Hwy 95 (visible from the hwy.) on unpaved road. This spectacular rugged high desert site is close to the south-western Oregon/Idaho border. Look for field trial signs.



Emergency Contacts/Disaster Plan

Weather conditions are usually not extreme in southwest Idaho, in the high desert area of mile post #9, during September. Temp. ranges from 30-60 at night and 40-70 or warmer during daylight hours, which are 7am-8pm, Mountain daylight savings time zone (MDST).

A first aid kit and satellite phone will be available at the field trial site. Water will be provided for the dogs and horses. The field trial grounds are located ¾ mile east of Hwy 95 entrance (unpaved road).

2006 GSPCIdaho Fall Field Trial Results

The annual GSPCI Fall Field Trial was held September 15-17, 2006, at the Milepost #9 trial grounds. Until three days before the start of the trial, daytime temps had been in the low 90's, but a sudden change brought much cooler weather and windy conditions for the dogs and handlers. Friday's All-Age event kicked off early in the morning, and the seven braces ran longer than expected, because three of the biggest runners covered more ground than a 30-minute brace allowed. The hard-working judges were Jeff Hull (Middleton, ID) and Heinz Ahlman (Graham, WA). One GSP made it to a chukar stronghold atop the highest ridge, but had to be rescued and brought down on horseback. The scout had to walk and lead the horse down off a rocky ledge. The event winner was "Tankk", aka Budd's Patriot, owned by Bill Rowekamp, of Sonoita, AZ and handled by Eldon Hongo, of Cheyenne, WY. This veteran 5-year-old GSP takes home the AKC blue ribbon, GSPCI 1st place trophy and NGSPA Certificate of Win.

Friday's second event was Open Limited Gun Dog, with ten starters. The judges were Larry Sandusky (Meridian, ID) and Linda Cross-Randolph (Boise, ID). The dogs made a good run for the cash prize, which was 50% of the entry fees, split 60/40 between 1st and 2nd place. The \$300 purse went to the winner, Council Mountain "Buzz" Saw (owned and handled by George Wilson of Council, ID) and Rawhide "Dixie" Lee Clown (o/h Rick Dodge, of Wilder, ID). Third place was awarded to 3D's Dixie's "Mocha" Jo (o/h Rick Dodge). A note of interest: Buzz and Mocha are Dixie's offspring and 3-yr.old litter mates.

Saturday's events were held on two courses, with Open Puppy and Open Gun Dog running concurrently. The judges for Open Puppy were Sharon Millsbaugh (Kuna, ID) and George Wilson (Council, ID). The young dogs were eager to hunt, and 4 awards were given: 1st place (AKC rosette and trophy) went to Red Sky "Riley", a 9-month-old Brittany, owned and handled by David Kirk. 2nd place went to Lonewolf's Huachuca "Jake", a 6-month hold GSP, o/h by Dean Crabbs of Vale, OR. 3rd place was awarded to Prairie Winds' Eat "Mya" Dust (11 months old), owned by Keith & Bobbi Richardson of Cheyenne, WY and handled by Eldon Hongo. 4th place went to Winsong's Rez Pisztoly "Stoly" (almost 15 months old), o/h by Warren Eizman, of Fallbrook, CA.

The Open Gun Dog event had 12 strong starters and two experienced judges, Larry Sandusky (Meridian, ID) and Gary Moen (Boise, ID). Weather conditions, with strong gusting winds and cold temps, made for a challenging course. Three dogs qualified for the call-back, in this retrieving stake, and only one placement could be awarded. 2nd place was awarded to 3D's Dixie's Mocha Jo, owned and handled by Rick Dodge (Wilder, ID).

The Open Derby was judged by Sharon Millsbaugh and George Wilson, who braved deteriorating weather conditions, along with the dogs and handlers and horses. A vizsla, GSP's and a brittany competed in this stake. 1st place was awarded to Rubyridge's

Megadot "Dot", owned and handled by Larry Sandusky (Meridian, ID). Other placements were withheld.

Sunday dawned calm and beautiful, for the running of the Amateur Gun Dog stake. Judges Heinz Ahlman and George Wilson were saddled up and ready to ride early, and the dogs appeared eager to go. The event was dominated by German shorthaired pointers, with two wirehaired pointers in the running also. Three dogs qualified for the call-back, and three awards were made. 1st place was awarded to 3D's Dixie's Mocha Jo (o/h Rick Dodge), 2nd place was withheld, 3rd place awarded to NC's Pride Gus (o/h by Emmett Burns of Meridian ID) and 4th place to FC/AFC Rader's One Over Par "Bogey", owned and handled by Ken Rader, of Chester, CA.

Special gratitude is due to the judges and volunteers, who made this three-day event possible. The judges (listed in the stakes) did an outstanding job of maintaining high standards of performance, even in the adverse weather conditions. Thanks to David Kirk, Dean Crabbs, Rod and Linda Randolph, Tom Gooding, Jon and Ann Young, George and Joan Wilson, and Rick and Linda Dodge for hauling hay, water, birds, drinks and food, horses, the portapotties, etc. and to other club members who supported this event with paperwork, paying bills, and publicity!
