## ***2004 WCA Mid-America Field Classic & Mid-America Field Futurity***

**Grounds:** The grounds are typical of an East Texas prairie, there are open fields tree lines rolling hills and plenty of water on the course. Over twenty-five hundred acres of field trial paradise, the grounds are easy to ride and give great opportunity to show a dog.

The amenities of the grounds include a cabin that will serve as the trial headquarters complete with screened in porch fireplace and some indoor plumbing. Also located on the grounds are several small fenced corrals and barn areas for holding horses. Horses may also be staked out in the camping area. Please be responsible for any cleanup in your area and fill in any ruts. Although they have only recently been opened to field trailers for trials they have already hosted the Visla National Championships in 2004, and have served as the grounds for the Texas Open for the past two years.

Hay will be available for a fee information on cost and location will be posted on the grounds.

**Horses:** Bottom Creek Farm, owned and operated by Will and Kathi Langley, are once again supplying top quality equine for the event. Please contact them at (810) 724-3426 or via email [Will@bottomcreekfarm.com](mailto:Will@bottomcreekfarm.com) to reserve handlers or gallery horses prior to the trial.

**Camping:** Camping on the grounds is permitted \$30 for the entire trial or \$6 per day. There are no available electric or water hookups. Water is available on the grounds for horses and dogs. There is a dump station located within a few miles of the grounds it is S. on 19 at the Shady Lake RV Park.

**Food:** Food will be available during the running of the trial. Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be cooked by several of the Trinity Valley Weimaraner Club's best chefs. Join us on Monday evening for a "Welcome to the MAC " get together on the grounds. Food for the week will be \$60 or you may purchase individual meals at \$3 for breakfast, \$5 for lunch and \$6 for dinner.
