COURSES AND BIRDS

All stakes will be run on single courses without birdfield. Quail and/or chukar released on back course. Chukar and/or pheasant used for retrieving – callbacks at judges' discretion.

Open All Age, Open Gun Dog, Amateur Gun Dog are retrieving stakes.

Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes.

A blank cartridge will not be fired in the puppy stake.

Tracking collars will be permitted in all stakes as per AKC rules.

PRIZES

Trophies & Standard AKC rosettes to all placed dogs.

WCA Rotating Trophies to the first place dog in Open All-Age, Field Futurity and Amateur Gun Dog.

50% of entry fees (net of ground use and other such fees) in the Open All-Age,

Open Derby and Open Gun Dog to be divided as follows:

40%-30%-20%-10% if four placements; 50%-30%-20% if three placements;

70%-30% if two placements; and 100% if one placement.

If first through fourth places in a money stake are withheld, prize money portion of the entries will be retained by WCA Treasurer and added to the purse for the same stake next year.

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DIRECTIONS:

The grounds are located at Jones Corral in Spenceville Wildlife Area about 60 miles due north of Sacramento, CA. For those familiar with the Waldo Corral area where we hold our club trial it is "just around the corner".

From CA Hwy 20 between Marysville and Grass Valley near Smartville turn right at CDF/Beale Air Force Base sign (if you get to the fire station on your left then you went too far). Go 0.9 miles, bear left (do not take Hammonton-Smartville Rd). Continue south on Smartville approximately 4.4 miles and bear left onto Waldo Rd. Go approximately 1.8 mile further, after crossing bridge veer left onto Spenceville Rd for .5 miles. Jones Corral road is on right.

From CA Hwy 49. Take Hwy 20 towards Marysville Rd. Go 12.2 miles, turn left at CDF/ Beale Air Force Base sign (this is Smartville Rd but does not say it). Go .9 mi and you will see a sign for HML-Smartville Rd, bear left on Smartville Rd for 4.4 miles. Turn then left on Waldo Rd. Go approximately 1.8 mile further, after crossing bridge veer left onto Spenceville Rd for .5 miles. Jones Corral road is on right.
