COURSES AND BIRDS

Tracking collars will be permitted in all stakes as per AKC rules.

Pheasants and /or Quail and/or Chucker to be released for all stakes.

Open All-Age to be run on a continuous course. All others to be run on either continuous or single course. Open All-Age, Open Gun Dog & Amateur Gun Dog are retrieving stakes.

Callbacks are at judges' discretion. A blank cartridge will not be fired in the puppy stake.

Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes.

PRIZES

Prizes and AKC rosettes to all placed dogs.

WCA rotating trophies to first place dog in Open All-Age, Amateur Gun Dog and Open Derby. 50% of entry fees (net of ground fees and other such fees) in the Open All-Age, Open Gun Dog and Open Derby Classics to be divided among first through fourth place dogs as follows: 40%-30%-20%-10% if four placements, 50%-30%-20% if three placements, 70%-30% if two placements, and 100% if one placement.

If first through fourth places in a money stake are withheld, prize money portion of entries will be retained by WCA Treasurer and added to the purse for the same stake next year.

Futurity placements and medallions awarded according to WCA field futurity rules.

GROUNDS

Rolling hills, babbling brooks, open meadows, forested ridges, and a lake nestled in the middle of it all—that's Ionia State Recreation Area. Forty-five hundred acres of Central Michigan's scenic lands comprise the Ionia multi-use recreation area. This area supports many activities such as fishing, hunting, swimming, boating, and snowmobiling. There are two rustic campgrounds and one modern campground, fifteen miles of equestrian trails, nine miles of bicycle trails, and three and one-half miles of hiking trails. Here, also, is where the Ionia Field Trial Grounds are located.

These grounds are continually being maintained, upgraded and expanded to provide the ideal area to train and contend top performing field trial dogs. The amenities include a comfortable club house with a full kitchen service, a fireplace to snuggle up to on those cold Michigan days and nights, and last but certainly not least, indoor washrooms. The grounds also have a barn with indoor & outdoor standing stalls, and several outdoor pipe corrals (persons using a pipe corral are responsible for its clean-up).

HORSES

CAMPING

Camping on the grounds is permitted with Michigan DNR Camping permits costing \$6.00 per day (registration/payment envelopes are located in piling at entrance to the grounds). A limited number of electrical hookups are available for campers for an additional \$6.00 per day (Get into camp early if you need hydro! Our hydro collector-June Beaven will be around collecting from those plugged in). Michigan DNR Vehicle parking permits are \$4.00 daily and Annual vehicle parking permits are \$24.00 (good for all Michigan State Parks). The Michigan DNR officers inspect the parking area daily and will happily sell you the parking/camping passes (keep an eye out for their green truck).

FOOD

Food will be available during the running of the trial. Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be cooked by several of the Weimaraner Club of Greater Cleveland's best chefs.
